Liberia is about the size of the state of Ohio, which is not very big. It is a tropical country which means it is hot and humid. They have a dry time and a rain time. Liberia has 40 percent of the Rain Forest of West Africa. This little girl lives in the rain forest up country in the "bush". Her drinking water comes from a stream where they wash their clothes, take their baths and toilet. This is NOT safe water to drink, but it is the only water they have.

Wells are needed to have clean good water. Some of the foods in Liberia to eat are all kinds of tropical fruits, rice, sugar cane, vegetables, monkey, bush hog and antelope, Giant African Rat, Pigmy Hippo, Crocodile, Iguana, porcupine, snake, and birds. Fish also are available, but they are totally different than the fish in Alaska.
