

Summer has been very busy for the Board of Directors of the Kuwaa Mission. After the face to face meeting in Alaska the board members spread across the US to thank supporters and introduce the mission to others who had not heard about what God is doing through ordinary people.

#### Lord of Life

(June 17-20) Rev. Dick Thompson visited with Karen and discussed with her the upcoming missionary training for the Alaska Volunteer team set to travel to Liberia during the 2012-2013 dry season.

National LWML Convention (June 23-26-2011) The Lutheran Women Missionary League Convention of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS) was a wonderful spirit filled event. It was four days full of sharing the Kuwaa Mission and celebrating what God is doing in the Kuwaa villages of Liberia. Rev. Jensen Sevenkulo and Lolitha Shepard shared with over 4,000 men, women and children the need for wells and clean water in the 16 villages of the Kuwaa Chiefdom. The mission was truly blessed to be a part of the convention. We are grateful to God and to those who made this possible. The Board of Directors waits with great anticipation for the next convention!

#### NCM Conference

(July 7-10-2011) Ed and Diane Stelling introduced the Kuwaa Mission to the National Children's



Ministry Conference (LCMS) (Sandals to Sneakers) which meets every 3 years. The Stellings made contact with other organizations such as the Malaria Initiative of Lutheran World Relief and the Children's Christian Concern organization, working with Christian schools in Liberia. There were numerous Lutheran school and Sunday school educators who stopped by the booth and expressed interest in adopting the Kids4Kuwaa mission project.

#### WELCA Gathering

Rev. Seyenkulo and Cindy Ellis were joined by Bekki Ellis to host a booth about the Kuwaa Mission at the Women of the ELCA Triennial Gathering in Spokane, Washington from July 14-16. They had an opportunity to introduce the Kuwaa Mission to about 2,000 people. They also demonstrated the filters that the mission has provided to the Kuwaa people, signed up many to receive the Prayer Letter, and enrolled many in the

\$12Klub4Kuwaa. (Twelve dollar members agree to support the mission with a contribution of \$1.00 a month.)

Leymah Gbowee, one of Liberia's "Iron Ladies", was a guest speaker at the Gathering. Ms. Gbowee visited the Kuwaa Mission booth and even mentioned it in her address. Leymah called on all women to "Rise up, reclaim your space, and let good overcome evil." Visit
