Merry Christmas & A Happy New Year

To all of our Friends and Partners we wish you a very Merry Christmas and a Happy 2012.

Thank you for your friendship and the partnership. You made things happen.

Here are some of the ways the Lord used you this past year:

Wells:

The Kuwaa Mission dug and retrofitted five wells in five Kuwaa villages and delivered more filters that remove contaminants from stream water. This provides a source of safe drinking water and is reducing the rate of diarrhea, cholera and typhoid among the children.

Evangelist Training:

The Kuwaa Mission is dedicated to spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We have partnered with the Lutheran Church in Liberia (LCL) to provide trained evangelists for the purpose of preaching the Gospel. Three young men were trained through phase one and two of the Lay Training Center Program of the LCL. Thanks to Pastor Lydia Manawu Weagbah and her assistant, Pastor Finn Hoggard, the Kuwaa evangelists are receiving the best training the LCL can offer.

Clinic:

With the designated funds from Lord of Life the Kuwaa Mission started building a medical clinic in the region, in Kondesu. Most of the blocks for the foundation and walls have been made. A contractor has been selected by the Board of Directors and construction work is set to begin early 2012.



School Supplies:

Thanks to the Kids4Kuwaa program, the Kuwaa Mission brought school supplies such as notebooks, pencils, pencil sharpeners, and books on tape to the Kuwaa towns.

Medical Supplies:

Some of the Kuwaa Mission partners have chosen to help provide some basic medical needs. Thanks to these partners, the Kuwaa Mission supplied villages with health kits and simple medications. Some villages have health personnel who can dispense such supplies and drugs.

501(c)3 Status:

Bethany Lutheran Church in Slidell, LA continues to serve as the Kuwaa Mission sponsoring church. The Board is grateful. The Mission is now incorporated

in the state of Illinois as a non-profit organization and in Liberia as a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO). The Board is presently working on a 501(c)3 status with the US Federal Government.

Nurses/lab tech Training:

In collaboration with ChildFund International, the Kuwaa Mission has plans to train nurses and lab technicians who will serve the Kuwaa people. Interviews were conducted this year and prospective students have sat the entrance exams. The first students in this program will enroll in the 2012 academic year.

Immediate Future

Three wells are currently being dug. These wells are set to be completed at the height of the dry season.

Two volunteers, Cindy Ellis and Ed Stelling, are set to go into the villages and provide some teachers training to the village teachers.

Samaritans' Purse will transport the Mission's construction materials to the project sites after they have been purchased.
