We have so much to be thankful for here at the Kuwaa Mission. The Lord continues to bless the mission with faithful prayer and financial supporters who share their love and concern for the Kuwaa people in Liberia, West Africa. This month our CEO, Rev. Dr. Samuel Jensen Seyenkulo, is in Liberia to assess the progress that our mission has accomplished this year and make plans for our next volunteer team going to the Kuwaa Chiefdom next March.

The mission plans to dig new wells in 2 villages, rebuild a well destroyed by the civil war in a 3<sup>rd</sup> village, continue work on the medical clinic, conduct teacher training and water filter use workshops, and survey with Samaritan’s Purse in several villages about animal husbandry and fish farming. Cindy Ellis, returning for 3<sup>rd</sup> time, and Ed Stelling, former Literacy missionary, will be the volunteers. They need your prayers as they prepare for their trip and funds to support their mission trip to Liberia and the Kuwaa.
